- Description/Theme:** SE Michigan AC (SEMAC) and Northern Ohio Virtual AC (NOVA) are planning a joint camping rally for June 2021 near Traverse City MI at Holiday Park Campground which was at one time an Airstream Park. Come visit old and make new friends while exploring beautiful NW Michigan. While it is a somewhat "structured" rally, there will be multiple options for daily activities to consider. The cost would only be the cost of camping (paid directly by each attendee), as well as the cost of any food, restaurant meals and activities (national park pass, kayak rentals, etc). It is a family oriented campout/rally. Bring your pop can tops, as we are collecting to take to International!

Every site offers 30/50 amp, full hookups, cable, fire rings and picnic table. Propane, firewood and a small camping supply store is available onsite. There is an onsite free dumping station. There is a small sandy beach and kayak rentals onsite. There is also a boat launch by the beach.

- Reservations:** Each rig will make their reservation by calling the campground after January 5, 2021 and indicating your attendance at the Silver on Silver Lake Airstream rally in the Ridge area. A deposit will be required at the time of reservation. Notification of attendance (name, rig information and number of attendees) should also be sent to the rally coordinators noted above so we can ensure the campground keeps all attendees together. You can reserve dates before and after the rally to continue your regional fun! We will be putting together a "things to see and do" bulletin for you to plan your non-rally activities.
- Payments & Rules:** Payment for your site fee will be made directly to the campground. Site fees will be @65.00 per night, with a 10% discount for anyone reserving in January, 2021. There is a \$3 reservation processing fee with the campground. All cancelled reservations are subject to a \$15 cancellation fee. Reservations are non-refundable within 7 days of arrival. No refunds for early departures. No Motorcycles permitted in the park. Pets permitted but not on beach. Make sure to read the full cancellation policy on the campground website in case updates are made.

Rally and Other Fees: No rally fee. Optional sightseeing and eating attractions may have a charge. An optional 50/50 raffle will be conducted during the rally to help cover the clubs' costs of the event. Any excess monies from the raffle proceeds once rally expenses are covered will be donated to a Region 4 charity.

Reservation Deadline: April 15, 2021 will ensure that we get all campers in the same general area of the campground, although we have obtained 12 sites confirmed next to each other. After we have 12 confirmed airstreams, we will work with the campground to place attendees in the same vicinity as best we can. Reservations can still be made up to April 15, but we cannot guarantee availability nor your site placement.
